 - o Nature: provide a description of this drug including how it is made and what it looks like

 - Effects: list the short and long term effects on the body.
 - Reference: acknowledge all information sources used in your presentation.
- **PART B** Create a collage to represent the impact of using this **drug on an individual and on the community.** This can be completed on an A4 Word Doc with electronic images or on an A4 paper with magazine/newspaper images.
