

Secondary Deputy Principal's Report

A busy Term 1 has come to an end, after a number of events such as Lots of Socks Day, Cross Country, King of the Court Dodgeball and many more. This wide variety of exciting and educational events for our students will continue early in Week 1 of Term 2.

Former NRL player Alan Tongue will visit the school to deliver the Voice Against Violence workshops to students in Years 9-12. The purpose of these workshops is to increase participants' awareness and understanding of the serious issue of gender-based

violence. Participants are provided with insights into what this violence is, the different forms it takes, the consequences and why it occurs.

Early in Term 2, students from Years 7-10 will participate in the WWI Living History incursion. Shane Blackman will return the school with an interactive look at the life of our soldiers and nurses in The Great War. This WW1 education workshop ensures that future generations of Australians do not forget the sacrifice made by the 330,000 men and women that served during WW1. This incursion has been a great success in the past and we look forward to the impact it will have on the budding young historians in Stage 4 and 5 here at LRCS.

In order for our students to take part in these amazing activities they need to be here at school. Of course 'Everyday Counts', but so does every minute. Students are expected to be at school by 8:40 am, in full school uniform, with all necessary equipment, so that they can be successful in their learning. This workshop is free and is the only opportunity students have to learn the dances.



Priscilla and Tom have been nominated not only for their outstanding contribution to the language and culture within the area but also for their humble personas and dedication to the wider school community.




